Dr. David Esleck: Performer, Composer, Producer, Educator. Although experienced as a multi-instrumentalist, he focuses on the piano, both as a soloist and with the David Esleck Trio. He is heard in concerts and recitals around the country, including performances for and with Presidents, heads of state, CEO's, Hollywood stars, and musical figures like The Preservation Hall Jazz Band and Tony Bennett. His latest release, on Yesyes Records, "Little Ears," was listed on the ballot for the GRAMMY awards, and is available on Amazon.com, Pandora, and Spotify.

Jason Jenkins, bass, is a graduate of Hampton University in Hampton, VA. A "Downbeat Magazine" award winner, he appears both as a sideman and with his own group, The Jason Jenkins Quartet. Jason's latest recording with that group, "Aphelion," is currently in release.
